### ONE ADDITIONAL BROADWAY SHOW TO BE ANNOUNCED:

Three-time Tony nominee **Kelli O'Hara** (*South Pacific*) will join Tony-winner **Matthew Broderick** (*The Producers*) in the upcoming musical, *Nice Work if You Can Get It*. Directed by Kathleen Marshall, the show features music by George Gershwin and a book by Joe DiPietro. The musical is set to begin performances in April, 2012 depending upon theatre availability. Another show under consideration is *Bonnie & Clyde*, starring Laura Osnes (*Anything Goes*) as Bonnie and Jeremy Jordan (*West Side Story*) as Clyde, with music by Tony Award-nominee Frank Wildhorn and lyrics by Tony-winner Don Black (*Sunset Boulevard*).
