




Christmas in New York City December 5-9, 2019

AIN'T TOO PROUD • This musical follows **The Temptations'** journey from the streets of Detroit to the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. TO KILL A MOCKINGBIRD • Published in 1960, Harper Lee's debut novel, *To Kill a Mockingbird*, was an immediate success. Inspired by Lee's own childhood in Alabama, it features one of literature's towering symbols of integrity and righteousness in the character of Atticus Finch, based on Lee's father. Now, for the first time ever, Lee's open-hearted dissection of justice and tolerance in the American South has been brought vividly to life on the Broadway stage with **Aaron Serkin's** new play, directed by Tony Award-winner, **Bartlett Sher**, and **Jeff Daniels** as Atticus Finch. **(Dec. 8 at 2pm)**


