Seraph Brass was founded to elevate and showcase the excellence of female brass players and highlight musicians from marginalized groups both in personnel and in programming. The ensemble tours around the world primarily as a quintet and is currently in residency at the Walton Art Center’s Artisphere Festival.



Anthony Trionfo, flute & Albert Cano Smit, piano - February 26, 2024

Flutist **Anthony Trionfo** is actively building one of today’s most exciting musical careers. Pianist **Albert Cano Smit** is also enjoying a growing international career. Performing together, these talented young artists represent the bright future of classical music.



Galvin Cello Quartet - March 18, 2024

Composed of members from China, Brazil, South Korea, and USA, **Galvin Cello Quartet** burst onto the scene after capturing the silver medal at the 2021 Fischhoff Competition. Using the limitless range of a cello ensemble, the group’s mission is to establish the cello quartet as a core part of the classical music world.

All series concerts will be presented at Sunrise Theater starting at 7:30 p.m. A subscription to all four concerts is \$96pp for Arts Council members (\$115 for nonmembers). Tickets to single concerts is \$35 each.
