NEW BROADWAY MUSICAL "REDWOOD"





"SARGENT & PARIS" AT THE MET



Coinciding with the 100th anniversary of John Singer Sargent's death, *Sargent & Paris* at the **Metropolitan Museum of Art** includes approx. 100 works of art—from preparatory sketches to daring masterpieces to his iconic *Madame X*. Follow the artist's rapid rise from his arrival in Paris as an 18-year-old art student through his scandalous success at the Paris Salon in the mid-1880s.

Vermeer's Love Letters, pairs the Frick's Mistress & Maid with loans from the Rijksmuseum & the National Gallery of Ireland causing you to ponder Vermeer's treatment of the letter theme & his depiction of women of different social classes.

OPTION NOGUCHI SCULPTURE GARDEN *Select at Registration*



Artist Isamu Noguchi founded the Noguchi Museum in 1985—the first U.S. museum created by a living artist to show their own work. Widely viewed among his greatest achievements, the museum offers one of the most dramatic art installations in NYC. (Cost: \$56pp)
