Don't miss this Tauck river cruise waltzing along the "river of kings," visiting Prague, Vienna, Salzburg, Budapest, & more. Be as active as you like with many options for walking tours & bike excursions. Enjoy the music of Mozart, an Imperial evening in a Viennese palace, fruits of the Wachau Valley vineyards, & visits to some of the world's leading art museums. This is trip of a lifetime!

<u>DAYS 1 & 2 – DEPART USA</u> | Arrive Prague where a transfer is included from the airport to the **Fairmont** Golden Prague Hotel for a 2-night stay. Begin your amazing journey with an evening of classical cultural treasures including a welcoming reception, tour & dinner at the 16th century **Lobkowicz Palace**. (Meals: D)



<u>DAY 3 – A DAY IN PRAGUE</u> | Walk through the centuries in Prague's **Old Town**. This excursion has two versions, one shorter & requiring less walking **OR** the city's poignant Jewish sites in **Josefov**, the historic Jewish Quarter. This afternoon, your choices in the ancient Castle district include the 1,000-year-old **Prague Castle** & its courtyards & gardens; the Gothic **Cathedral of St. Vitus**; & the grand Baroque libraries of **Strahov Monastery**. Then sample the culinary pleasures of Prague on a free night to spend as you wish. (Meals: B)

<u>DAY 4 – REGENSBURG</u> | Enjoy a morning to explore Prague as you wish **OR** venture off to the Bavarian city of **Regensburg**, whose roots stretch back to Roman days. This afternoon, we drive to Germany to board the riverboat for a 7-night cruise. Enjoy a welcome reception & dinner onboard. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 5 – AUSTRIA</u> | Our first port of call will be **Austria's Engelhartszell**, where we visit a private home to taste local cake & coffee before making a choice of a **walking tour** of the 18th century town **OR** a guided tour of the **Jochenstein Lock** through which ships navigate the **Wachau Valley**. Afterwards, join an optional, fairly rigorous bicycle excursion along the Danube to Aschach, before continuing to Linz. After a Chef's signature dinner this evening enjoy the musical trio, **Donau 3Klang**, as they entertain onboard. (Meals: B/L/D)

DAY 6 – SALZBURG, CESKY KRUMLOV OR LINZ | Choose a full-day excursion to Salzburg OR to Cesky Krumlov in Czech Republic OR remain in Linz. A walking tour explores Salzburg's Old Town, Mirabell Gardens & Mozart's birthplace (right) with free time for lunch & exploration. Or travel to Cesky Krumlov for a walking tour of Krumlov Castle; It's worth it to climb the many steps to see this medieval, Renaissance & Rococo design found inside. Overnight on our riverboat in Linz tonight. (Meals: B/L/D)



DAY 7 – WACHAU VALLEY | Continuing through the Wachau Valley, we dock in Durnstein for a look at its 16th century Baroque houses & Romanesque church **OR** take a bike ride in the valley. Enjoy free time in this riverside town &, if you wish, climb the steps to see the ruins of a castle where Richard Lionhearted was held for ransom during the Crusades. Later, sample the fruits of the Wachau Valley vineyards during a wine tasting at an Austrian tavern before we depart for Vienna. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 8 – CHOICES IN VIENNA</u> | Arrive in Vienna overnight. An introductory tour of the former capital of the old Habsburg Empire precedes a walking tour focusing on medieval Vienna, complimented with various samples of the local cuisine. Or choose to enjoy a more active walking tour that concludes at the **Albertina**, one of the world's great art museums located inside a palace. An Imperial evening is scheduled tonight in the opulent Viennese **Palais Pallavicini** that played a role in the 1940s film noir classic, *The Third Man*. Cocktails & dinner precede a musical performance celebrating the legacy of Mozart. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 9 – MORE CHOICES</u> | Sightseeing choices this morning include a tour of the **Schönbrunn Palace**, an architectural masterpiece, **OR** the **Kunsthistorisches Museum Wien**, one of the world's most acclaimed art museums. The afternoon includes a cruise to neighboring **Slovakia** with dinner of Slovakian regional cuisine & an onboard performance by a troupe of Slovak dancers. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 10 – BAROQUE IN BRATISLAVA</u> | Begin the day with a lecture regarding contemporary **Slovakia & Bratislava** for a look at politics, economics, religion, & preservation of the arts. Afterwards, choose a walking tour of this vehicle-free city to see 17 centuries of history chronicled in various sites, **OR** take a bicycle excursion through the "Iron- Curtain Area" of Bratislava. Back aboard ship for dinner. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 11 – BUDAPEST – "PEST"</u> | Arrive in **Budapest**, **Hungary**, split into "**Buda"** & "**Pest"** by the Danube River. Following a visit to the **Opera House**, **City Park & Heroes**



Square, you have another choice: Explore the "Pest" side on a choice of walking tours at a slower or faster pace. Spend the afternoon at your leisure. With Budapest excellent reputation for cuisine, tonight's cocktail reception & dinner is at the grand **Akademia Club** in the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, including music by a Hungarian band. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 12 – BUDAPEST – "BUDA"</u> | Begin the day exploring "Buda" by heading up to Castle Hill, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, for a choice of sightseeing: A tour of Fisherman's Bastion with its Neo-Romanesque design & stained-glass windows in the 14th century late-Gothic Mathias Church OR visit the famed Szecheny Bath Spa. Our final night aboard the river boat begins with a farewell toast before dinner. (Meals: B/L/D)

<u>DAY 13 – RETURN HOME</u> | A transfer is included from the riverboat to Budapest's Airport. Allow at least three hours for check-in at the airport. (Meals: B)
