Caravaggio Revolution

Baroque Masterpieces from the Roberto Longi Foundation
Wednesday, July 8, 2026 | Mint Museum of Art, Charlotte

View the first exhibit in North Carolina in a century to shine light on how Caravaggio's radical realism transformed not only painting, but the very language of modern film, photography & popular culture. Caravaggio's masterful *Boy Bitten by a Lizard* (right) is the heart of this exhibit—a rare treasure among the fewer than 50 works attributed to the artist, who died at age 38. Surrounding this centerpiece are more than 30 paintings by leading Baroque masters & Caravaggisti from across Europe, artists who absorbed & reinterpreted Caravaggio's revolutionary style. These works illuminate the extraordinary impact of his use of shadow, light, realism, & dramatic intensity on an entire generation of painters.
